Graduations and alumnae/i reunions keep our associations busy. **Regis** hosted their 2nd Annual Alumni Tailgate in May. Alumni from across the decades gathered at **ASH-St**. **Charles** in June to celebrate the annual Alumni Congé Reunion, with Mass in the Shrine of St. Rose Philippine Duchesne, followed by recognition of Honor Classes from 5 years to 70 years. The Alumnae Interview Project at **Rosary** was a collaboration across disciplines to create connections between students and alumnae, to explore possible career paths, and to learn a variety of skills including asking open ended questions, responding with appropriate follow up questions, demonstrating interest through body language and other non-verbal skills, interacting with professionals, and thanking individuals for their time. Twenty-eight student pairs were partnered with an alumna in an industry or profession of their interest. They were tasked with researching the individual and their profession, coming up with interview questions, conducting the interview, and following up with a thank you note. Overwhelmingly, the alumni were impressed with the students' preparation and their ability to participate in a meaningful conversation.

Many of the schools in the Southern Region are welcoming new leadership. Heather Gillingham-Rivas '94 is the new Head of School and Patrick Coyle is the inaugural President at **Carrollton** School of the Sacred Heart. **ASH-St. Charles** welcomed Tim Horner, while saying *au revoir* to Dr. Susan Dempf who will become Head of School at Woodlands Academy of the Sacred Heart.
