

**Arienne WILLBERN | Duchesne Class of 2008**



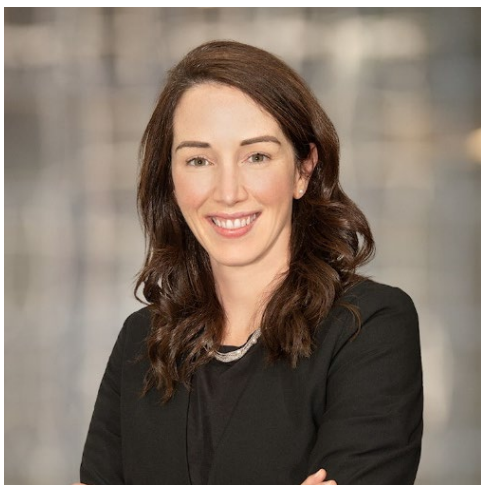
Arienne graduated from the University of Arizona in 2014 with a Bachelor of Science in Geology and a Bachelor of Arts in French Literature.
