TechnoCycle has the following accreditations:

R2 (Responsible Recycling)

This electronic recycling standard was developed by a multi-stakeholder group including the US EPA, state agency regulators, recyclers, OEM's, and non-Government Organizations (NGO's) to regulate domestic and international electronic recycling. This standard:

- a) Encompasses an EH&S system and complies with local, state, and national legal requirements.
- b) Adheres to a reuse, recover, and disposal management strategy.
- c) Allows conditional export of Focus Materials and "repairable" equipment (e.g. e-Waste, however TechnoCycle subscribes to a NO export of e-Waste and as-is or non-working material).
- d) Requires data destruction to NIST 800-88 Guidelines for Media Sanitization.
- e) Requires general liability insurance.
- f) Requires downstream due-diligence for e-Waste.

ISO 14001:2004 (Environmental Management System)

This international environmental management standard was developed to help international organizations: (a) minimize how their operations (processes etc.) negatively affect the environment (i.e. cause adverse changes to air, water, or land); (b) comply with applicable laws, regulations, and other environmentally oriented requirements, and (c) continually improve in the above.

OHSAS 18001:2007 (Occupational Health & Safety)

This widely used British health and safety management system exists to help all kinds of organizations put in place demonstrably sound occupational health and safety performance. It is widely seen as the world's most recognized occupational health and safety management systems standard
